Re: Vaccine Prioritization for Criminal Defense Lawyers

Dear Governor Kemp:

In late January 2021, a letter was sent on behalf of the Georgia Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers (GACDL) urging you to prioritize and include criminal defense lawyers in Phase 1-B of Georgia's COVID-19 Vaccine Administration. In light of the evolving nature of vaccine distribution, I write today to reiterate this request.

Today, Chief Justice Melton issued his 12th Judicial Emergency Order allowing for the resumption of jury trials, beginning immediately. anticipation of this Order numerous jurisdictions have summoned jurors and have begun scheduling jury trials. As a result, GACDL anticipates that its members will be required to personally appear in court for hearings and resume jury trials prior to the end of March 2021. Unvaccinated defense lawyers create a risk for all Georgians.

Criminal defense lawyers are essential to the criminal legal system and its proper functioning. Effective criminal defense requires direct contact with individuals who are incarcerated, both in preparation for and during trial, where the risk of exposure to disease is much greater. To ensure that effective assistance of counsel is provided, criminal defense lawyers cannot simply distance themselves from their clients. Criminal defense lawyers are eager to get back to trying cases and protecting their clients' constitutuonal rights but, understandably, desire to be safe and protected in the process.

GACDL understands that the original phases (1-A, 1-B, and 1-C) for vaccination eligibility are being eliminated in favor of adding groups of people (e.g., educators) to the original Phase 1-A list. In order to ensure the effective and safe operation of the criminal legal system, without unnecessarily exposing criminal defense lawyers to a deadly virus, GACDL urges you to prioritize criminal defense lawyers, by adding them to the list of people that are currently eligible for vaccination.
